PHARD 1641: Pharmacology I

This course sequence includes coverage of the pharmacologic actions of the major classes of drugs acting on the autonomic, cardiovascular, gastrointestinal, immune and central nervous systems. Other topics that are covered include the chemotherapy of microbial, parasitic and neoplastic diseases; drugs acting on blood and bloodforming organs, hormones and hormone antagonists, principles of toxicology, vitamins, and drugs causing birth defects.
